

Antifungal NAPS targeted audit 2025

- We invite all hospitals to participate in a targeted audit of antifungal prescribing in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU)
- Deep dive into the prescribing of antifungals in your ICU
- Benchmark quality and outcome metrics to similar facilities

WHY assess antifungal prescribing in ICU?

- Invasive fungal infections are common in critical care settings and are associated with high mortality
- Early appropriate treatment is crucial
- Assessing prescribing quality helps to reduce unnecessary use, toxicity, drug-drug interactions, resistance and minimises costs

HOW is Antifungal NAPS different?

- Deep dive audit to assess each phase of prescribing (Prophylaxis, empiric & directed therapy)
- Assess prescribing according to risk of infection
- Quality & outcome metrics specific for antifungal prescribing and invasive fungal infection

Participate in the 2025 Antifungal NAPS targeted audit

Who can participate?

 All Australian hospitals with an ICU, PICU or NICU are encouraged to participate

What is being audited?

- All patients initiated on an antifungal while being treated in the ICU
- Include all systemic antifungal prescriptions (oral, intravenous, inhaled...)

What time period should be audited?

- 1st January to 31st March 2025
- This audit is conducted retrospectively

How many prescriptions should be audited?

- All patients initiated on an antifungal in the ICU during the audit period
- If there are > 50 patients in your facility prescribed an antifungal in ICU, you may choose to restrict the audit to the <u>first</u> 50 patients

Submission deadline to participate in benchmarking
